France Takes the Lead in Europe's Defense Transformation

Europe's defense landscape is entering a new phase, one defined by intelligent mass production. As aerial threats multiply and geopolitical tensions rise, France has emerged as a continental leader, building on over a decade of experience in counterdrone warfare and a unique cross-force integration between the Air Force, police, and national security agencies.

Among them, MC2-Technologies stands out as a flagship of industrial agility. The Lille-based company generated €13.5 million in 2024 revenue (+22% YoY), targeting €16 million in 2025 and €50 million within three years. Its proprietary hyperfrequency systems can detect, identify, and neutralize all wireless communications, providing both French and international forces with an unmatched edge in electronic warfare. With 30% of sales exported and backing from Andera Partners, Bpifrance, and Tikehau, MC2 is on track to reach mid-cap scale, proof that European sovereignty can also mean economic acceleration.

At the high end of the spectrum, <u>Thales and Destinus are redefining scalable defense</u>. Their 2025 MoU targets 10,000 drones in 2025 and 100,000 by 2026, blending Destinus's AI-driven autonomous platforms with Thales's payloads, guidance, and resilient communications. The \$225 million acquisition of Daedalean, a Swiss AI aviation specialist, will equip the next generation of drones with certifiable autonomy and real-time swarm coordination. The message is clear: Europe is arming for scale: from MBDA's low-cost missiles to Thales—Destinus autonomous fleets.

The alliance between Harmattan AI (France) and Skyeton (Ukraine) further reinforces this strategy. Announced in October 2025, their partnership integrates Harmattan's military-grade sensor technology with Skyeton's Raybird UAS, a platform with over 350,000 combat flight hours and 28+ hours of endurance.

Moreover, <u>Alta Ares embodies this new generation of dual-use defense AI startups emerging from France's deeptech ecosystem</u>. Founded in 2024 and already validated in combat operations in Ukraine, the company raised €2 million in 2025 from investors including Expansion, Starburst Ventures, Durandal Capital, and Kima Ventures.

Complementing this software-driven approach, <u>Aerix Systems is redefining drone agility</u>. The startup has developed an omnidirectional propulsion system enabling 360° rotation, inverted flight, and high-speed stability up to 200 km/h. Its dual-use technology, backed by a €1.6 million seed round in 2024, positions Aerix as a rising

player in France's defense and aerospace innovation ecosystem.

Behind this surge, capital is following conviction. The Plural fund launched in 2022 and already managing €800 million across two vehicles, embodies the new breed of European venture capital focused on deeptech, defense, and critical technologies. With 50 investments across 9 countries, including Helsing (defense), Phasecraft (quantum), and Proxima Fusion (nuclear). Plural is doubling down on Europe's technological sovereignty. Its mission-driven approach is clear: invest in the innovators who will define Europe's strategic independence for the next decade.
